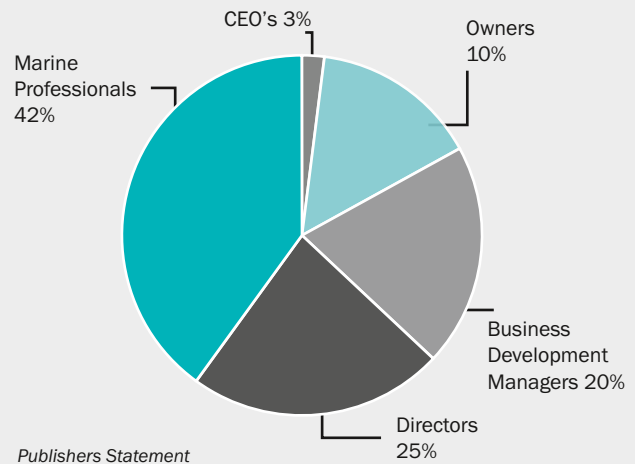

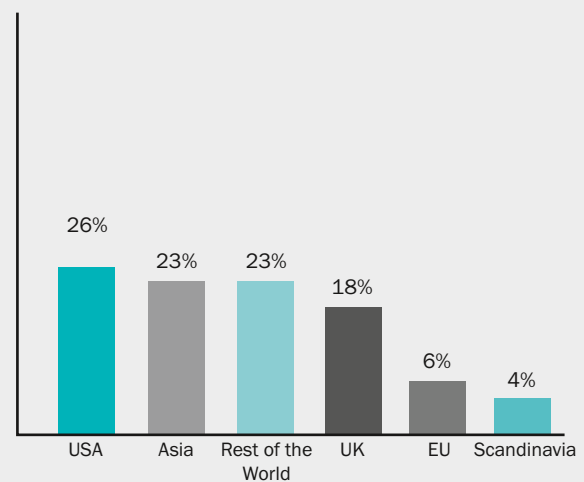

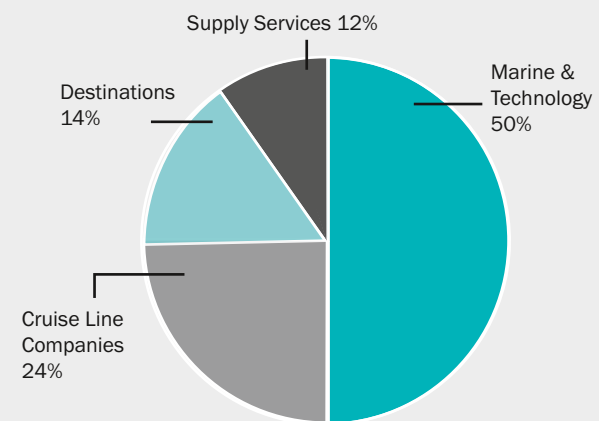

On 8th May, Transas and the Center for Simulator and Maritime Training (CSMART) - the training facility for Carnival Corp - have signed a multi-million euro contract to utilise Transas' simulators at CSMART's new facility, scheduled to open in summer 2016 in Almere, just outside Amsterdam.
